
SSA BOUNDARIES


Roughly the area between 1st and 7th Avenues and 13th and 28th Streets. Services performed supplement those provided by the City government and general property owner responsibilities.

SSA GUIDANCE

A 13-person Board of Directors and four Committees help govern and guide the use of the funds generated by the SSA. Total of 25 engaged stakeholders.

Approx. 215 individual property owners, 430 parcels & 65 blocks.




